Monthly Rainfall in Four Cities

The table below shows the amount of rainfall (in millimeters) for four cities – Tokyo, London, Sydney, and New York – over four months: January, February, March, and April.

There is also some extra information. In February, Sydney had a big storm, so the rain record was less than normal. Normally, Sydney gets about 130 mm of rain in February, but because of the storm, the measurements didn't work well and they only recorded 110 mm. In March, Tokyo had its driest month of the year. The rain was lower than the normal 80 mm for that month. Meanwhile, in April, New York received much less rain than usual, with only 70 mm, even though April is normally a rainy month for the city.
